KEY PRESENTATION	Andrew Kinch, GameAware
Guest Speaker Andrew Kinch, Director GameAware	The professional development component of today's meeting was delivered in response to feedback from network members who expressed a keen interest to receive information and advice on young people and the compulsivity of online gaming.
	Key speaker, Andrew Kinch of GameAware was engaged to offer insights into the culture and psychology of video games, and how, many young people derive their self-worth through the mastery of games and the ensuing comradery and credibility that can result in the 'online gaming world' that may be absent in real life.
	Andrew also discussed the benefits and challenges of video games for young people and how we, as youth professionals, can work with families and their children to establish healthy boundaries for gaming. Andrew's presentation concluded with a Q&A session.
	The feedback poll at the conclusion of the forum revealed 100 per cent satisfaction rate from 59 attendees indicating that the session exposed network members to new ideas or information.
	Opportunities to invite Andrew back again in 2022 will be explored, including the potential to host a more in-depth professional development session for youth sector professionals in Greater Dandenong.
